I am writing to you in relation to the International Summer School we are running here at the School of Chemistry, Trinity College Dublin. There are a limited number of places available and I would like to ask you to please bring the attached notice to the attention of students who may be interested in participating.

The Summer School is being organised in conjunction with the School of Chemistry, University of Bristol, UK, and is aimed at 5<sup>th</sup> year and transition year students who would like to engage together with secondary school students from the Bristol area in an exciting Chemistry experience. It will involve Irish students travelling to Bristol for the first part of the course and then returning to Dublin together with the Bristol area students for the second part. There will be about 50 students in the combined group.

The course offers a unique opportunity for travel, for interaction with students from a different educational system and for hands-on exposure to advanced methodology in world-class laboratories. It is not "all work and no play" either, as there is also plenty of social interaction.
