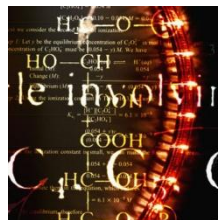
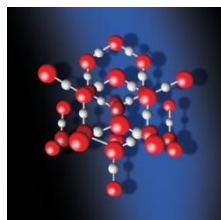

International Summer Chemistry Event Sunday 30th June to Friday 5th July 2013

This event, the eighth in the series, is being organised in conjunction with the School of Chemistry, University of Bristol, UK, and is aimed at 5th year and transition year students who would like to engage in a unique Chemistry experience together with secondary school students from the Bristol area. The event, part of which will take place in Bristol, will include joining in team-based "research projects" based in the state-of-the-art laboratories at Trinity College, at the University of Bristol and elsewhere. There will be visits to industrial facilities, a Chemistry quiz (with prizes) and it is expected that there will be a number of social events. Places, which are limited, will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. A booking deposit of €100 is required, and the total fee will be €375. This includes return air travel to Bristol and single room accommodation and evening meals at Bristol University. There will be an additional charge should you wish to carry checked-in luggage (prevailing rates on the day of booking will apply).
